EXAMINATION RULES - Midterm January, 2016

1. Carefully read your exam schedule. Starting times are **9:00 AM and 1:00 PM**. Take time to highlight the exams you will be writing.
2. Students arriving late, after the official start of the examination, must report to the office for a late slip. The invigilator will only admit the student who is late with this slip. Extra time is not given.
3. Students will **not** be permitted to write an examination **half an hour after** the start time of the examination. Students arriving more than 30 minutes late should report to the office.
4. Students will be permitted to leave an examination **only** after at least half the time has elapsed (minimum time **one hour**). Students are to **raise their hand** and **wait** for an **invigilator** to pick up the exam. Students **sign** the **attendance sheet** since this is the only way to prove that they wrote the exam.
5. Students must bring all relevant supplies to each exam, the school will **not issue** supplies. **All writing supplies, mathematical instruments, calculators, etc., must be in a clear zip-lock bag. No pencil cases.** Dictionaries, calculators etc., can only be used if the subject teacher has instructed students to do so and/or it is indicated on the exam paper. Check with your subject teacher ahead of the exam.
6. The **school uniform must be worn** during the examination period, even if coming in only for tutorials. Students will **not be allowed to write** an exam unless **in uniform**.
7. During the exam period, students are to be in school **only** when **writing examinations** unless attending planned tutorials with a teacher or studying at the library. The cafeteria will not be serving food during the exam period.
8. If for any reason the school is closed for a day, the examination will be rescheduled and the notice will be posted outside the main office, and on the school website.
9. In the case of **absence** from an examination a **medical certificate** is required; otherwise a mark of **0** will be given. Also, please note this applies to exams written during class time in the weeks leading up to the formal exam period. **Misreading the schedule is not an acceptable excuse.**
10. Cheating during an exam will result in a **0** for the **exam** and the student will be **expelled** from the exam room.
11. Coats, bags, food, books, notes and hats are **not permitted** in the examination room and must be left at the front of the exam room or at the front of the gymnasium.
12. **Electronic devices are not permitted in the examination room.** If the device is in the student's possession during an exam, **it will be considered as cheating** resulting in a mark of 0 for the exam. The item will be confiscated and the student will be expelled from the exam room.
13. To ensure that you are familiar with the date and time of your examination, **read the schedule carefully, check the information with the subject teacher and write it in your agenda.**
14. **Students are reminded to verify the blackboard located in the main lobby for the location of their exam. Class lists will be posted on the blackboard prior to the scheduled exam.**
15. Students are to report any exam conflicts to the office **immediately.**
16. The **role of the invigilator** is to supervise the exam and **not to answer any content related questions.** Students are encouraged to work through their exams and save any questions for their subject teacher.
